

Student visa – Documents to be submitted

Note: Mauritius will re-open its borders to students as from 15 July 2021. Students will still need to complete the 14 days of quarantine in one of the approved hotels before being able to circulate in Mauritius. More details on the reopening of Mauritius to travellers on <https://mauritiusnow.com/>

As per the Higher Education Commission (HEC), students need to be fully vaccinated against Covid-19 to have access on campus. They also need to have in their possession a negative PCR test carried out within 72 hours prior to departure for Mauritius.

- Original Form “Application to Enter Mauritius” duly filled in and signed by the applicant - [Download here](#)
- Two recent passport size photographs of the applicant
- Photocopy of the bio-data pages of the passport of the applicant
- Original letter of admission from ENSA Nantes (Mauritius)
- Original letter of offer from ENSA Nantes (Mauritius)
- Original letter of acceptance of offer signed by the applicant
- Original Documentary evidence of availability of funds or financial capacity to meet costs of study and stay in Mauritius
- An original medical certificate certifying that the applicant is not suffering from any contagious or infectious disease (HIV, Hepatitis B, and chest X ray).
- Documentary evidence of accommodation confirmation for the student’s stay in Mauritius (Original confirmation letter from the landlord, copy of the national identity card of the landlord and original utility bill (water or electricity) of the place of residence).

All original documents in the possession of the applicant need to be sent by express courier service (DHL, FedEx, UPS etc.) to:
